I UNDERSTAND THE FOLLOWING:

Adopting a companion animal is a great responsibility. I will be sharing my life with a pet who is totally dependent upon me for food, shelter, veterinary care, and love.

Except for medical reasons and extraordinary circumstances, we do not provide refunds for your adoption fee.

I am responsible for checking to see if the city in which I live requires animals to have a city license as well as other local laws, and I will obtain any required license and comply with all applicable local ordinances regarding this dog.

I will keep the HSPC identification tag in order to help identify the dog if it is lost.

I understand the need also for a tag with my phone # on it, if the dog gets lost.

I understand the need to keep my dog current on heartworm preventative and flea and tick preventative.

I understand that obedience training for the dog is very desirable because it will lead to improved behavior and communication between dogs and humans.

I understand that the HSPC cannot guarantee the health, temperament, or training of the animal and I hereby release the HSPC from all liability once the animal is adopted. **Please initial:** _____

I further understand that the HSPC does not adopt or foster animals to be put on chains. Adoptions will be nullified if the animal in question is placed on a chain. The HSPC upon a home check finding an animal on a chain, has the right to reclaim the animal at that time and return it to the HSPC.
